

# **1R06 06:04 Wolverhampton - London Euston**



## **A scenario for DTG's WCML South**

**Drive Avanti West Coast 390119 or 390155 on 1R06 from Birmingham New Street to London Euston on a sunny Wednesday morning in September 2020. It should be a relatively clear run today but keep on your toes, as it is the Railway after all, anything can happen!**

- **\*AP Sky & Weather Pack (If you don't have this, a default, unspecified standard weather pattern will be applied)\***
- **\*AP Signal Enhancement Pack (without this, you may get incorrect aspects)\***

(Anything with a \* next to it indicates that it's not essential to the running of the scenario, you can press F2 and 'OK' when the scenario starts, but you \*will\* see much less AI about)

**\*Please Note\***

- **Due to the resource-intensive nature of this scenario, it is recommended to turn your graphics settings down slightly.**
- **The scenario may freeze on loading. Please be patient, as it will unfreeze.**
- **As well as the scenarios, a fix for the 377/2's pantograph (so that the AI runs with it raised) has been provided. Huge thanks to **Ash Clark** for providing this!**
- **Two versions of this scenario are included. One utilising the default DTG Avanti livery, and one utilising Major Wales's Avanti Pride reskin. You can choose to install one or the other, or both. Simply go into the individual folder, and copy the Content folder into your Railworks install folder. (The other will still appear as an AI train, so you need to install Major Wales' Avanti Livery Pack either way)**
- **Your timings, as well as the timings of AI trains, are as per the October 2020 timetable.**
- **There is sometimes a known bug with the reskin where you will be unable to accelerate properly. If you experience this, then not to worry, simply re-install **AP's Class 390 Sound Pack** to fix it.**
- **You will notice fewer, if any trains stabled in yards and depots, for example Willesden. This is to save FPS.**
- **1973 Tube Stock substitutes for 1972 Tube Stock. The cab in the middle of the consists is as per the 1972 Tube Stock.**
- **A Class 150/1 in LM Livery substitutes for a Class 230 at Bletchley.**
- **I have tried my best to match Unit numbers with their correct and current livery as per real life, using Resources available. If you notice one that's in the incorrect livery, please contact me, and I will sort it out ASAP.**

**To install, simply copy the included Content and Assets folders into your Railworks folder.**
