You will be calling at most stations. As typical for a Friday evening, there are minor signalling issues in the Birmingham New Street Area. Hopefully this shouldn't delay you too much...

- *AP Class 350 Enhancement Pack*
- *AP Signal Enhancement Pack (without this, you may get incorrect aspects)*
- *AP Sky & Weather Pack (If you don't have this, a default, standard weather pattern will be applied)*
